

–Family Take and Return Library–

Who :

Families of preschool-elementary aged children
School staff: front office, reading teachers, and administrators

What :

A library of trending books that kids love to have read to them is created so that families can check the books out, read at home to their children, return them, and take new stories home again and again.

When and Where :

Families can access the library any time the school office is open if you decide to create the area in your school's front office.
If you decide to have the reading teachers control the inventory, the children can pick up and return books during reading group times throughout the week.

Why :

Families receive an expertly written lesson plan that they can carry out in their own home with their own children. This helps families struggling with knowing how to read to their children or if they don't know what materials would be best to read. This also helps families who don't naturally have a variety of children's books in their home, or can't afford one.
